## BYLAW NO. 691

### A Bylaw to Amend the Municipal Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw

The Council of the District of Elkford, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Schedule 1 to District of Elkford Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 626, 2001 is amended by adding the following:

Failure to supply list of sub-trades engaged on job sites	4.5	\$100
Home based business that alters the residential appearance or character of the building in which it is located	4.7	\$100
