

**District of Elkford
Bylaw No. 626**

A Bylaw to Implement the Municipal Ticket Information Procedure

WHEREAS section 272 of the *Local Government Act* authorizes the Council,

1. to designate those bylaws which may be enforced by means of a form of a ticket prescribed by regulation under Section 280(a) of the *Local Government Act*;
2. to designate bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of enforcing bylaws by means of a prescribed form of ticket;
3. to designate an offence against a bylaw by means of a word or expression on a ticket; and
4. in consultation with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court to set fines, not exceeding \$500, for contraventions of designated bylaws.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Elkford, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 272 of the *Local Government Act*;
2. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule 1 to this bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers pursuant to Section 272(1)(b) of the *Local Government Act* for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 opposite the respective job positions,
3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules 2 through 4 to this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words of expressions.
4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedule 2 through 4 to this Bylaw are the fines set pursuant to Section 272(5) of the *Local Government Act* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
5. This Bylaw may be cited as "The District of Elkford Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 626, 2001.
